#### NOTES

- "Residential Care Community" includes assisted living, personal care homes, adult care homes, board care homes, adult foster care, and similar arrangements.
- Percentages may be undercounted. The national averages may differ from figures reported in the Alzheimer's Association's Alzheimer's Disease Facts and Figures report for a couple of reasons. First, this table reports percentages for all users of long-term care services, irrespective of age; some of the percentages reported in Facts and Figures are the percentages of users aged 65 and older. Second, data reported on this table were collected from a survey of providers; some of the Facts and Figures percentages are based on an examination of data for individual users. If state-level data were available in the same manner percentages of those users aged 65 and older based on individual users' data the state percentages may be significantly higher, particularly for nursing homes.
