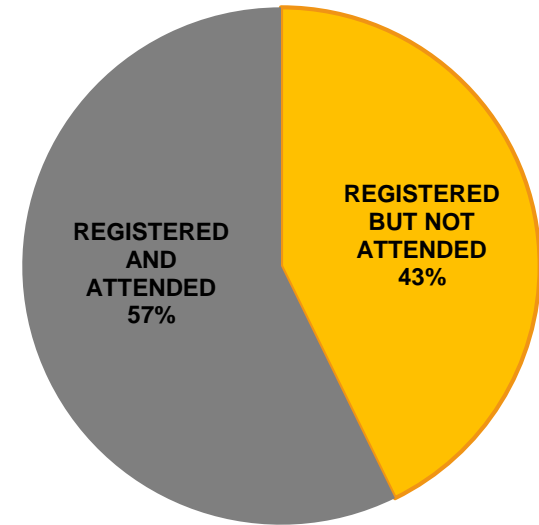

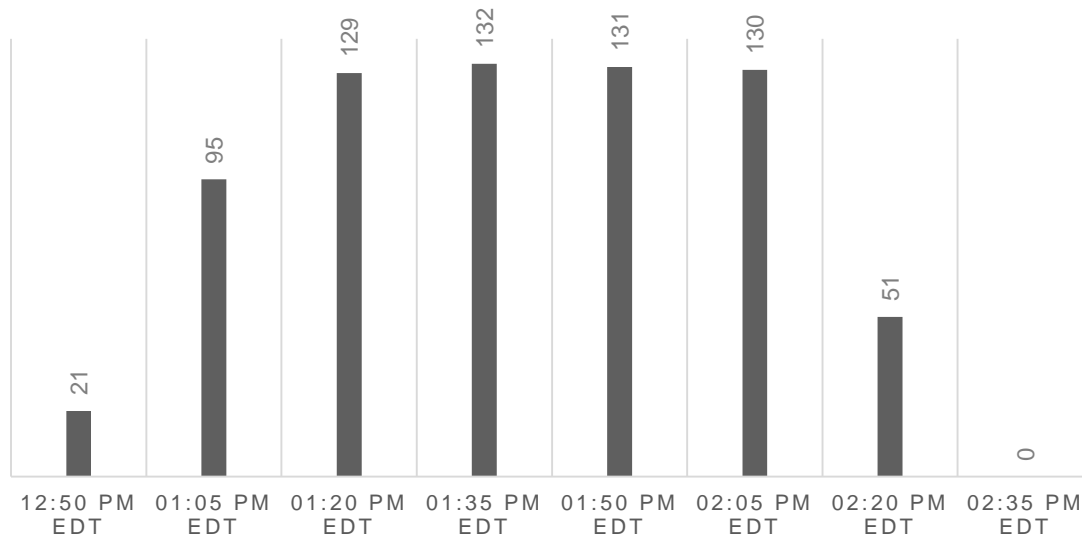

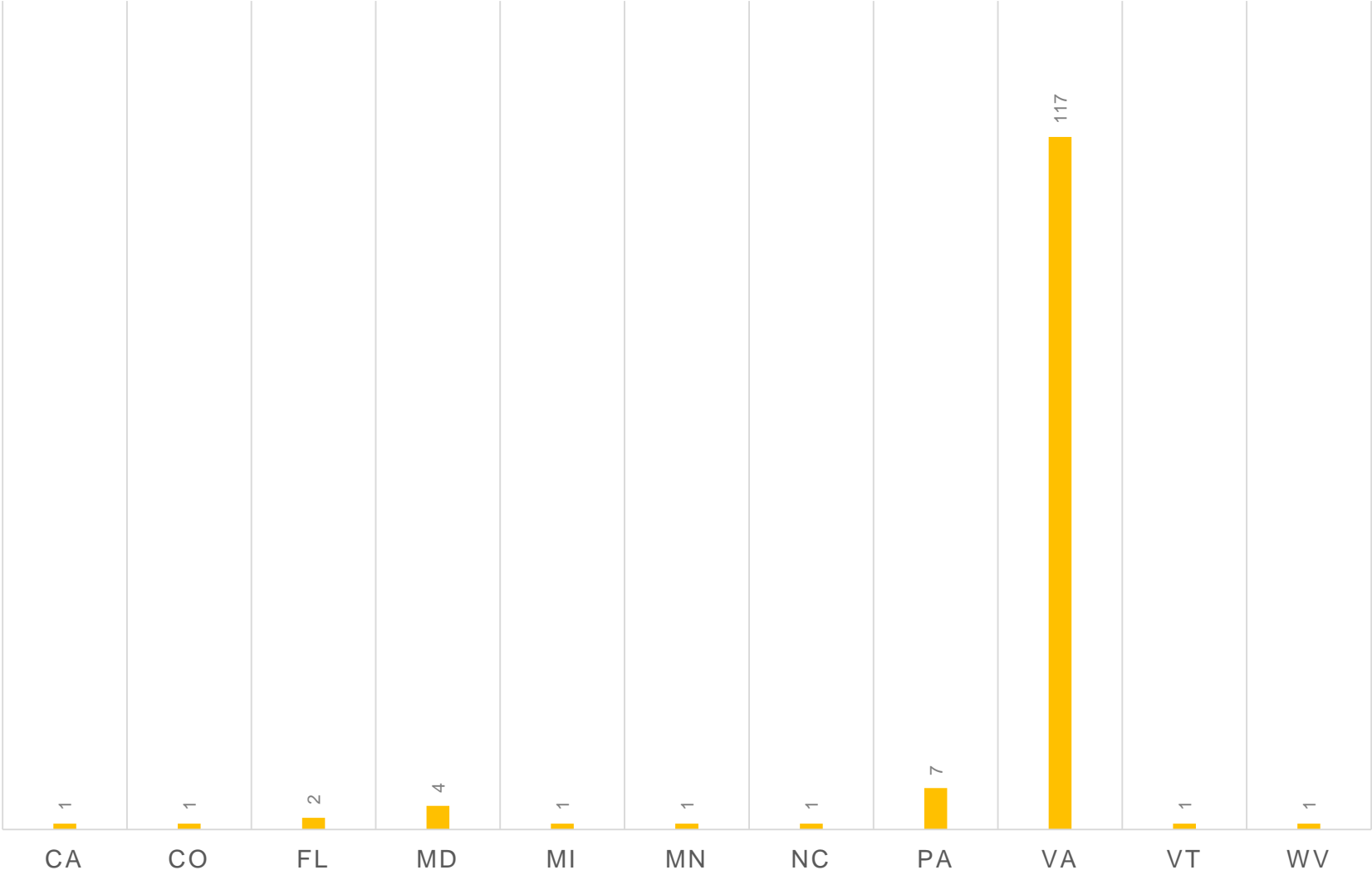
NUMBER OF ATTENDEES (#)
